

BASA Captains Pack

This is a basic information pack about BASA for Captains.

Money

Teams pay

- \$100 for mixed competition
- \$ 50 for Men's checking competition

This is paid to the Treasurer on the Night, or it can also be paid in advance, via internet banking. We will be encouraging net-banked fees 1 month in advance in the future.

Information

Game information, schedules, news, results, and bulletins are available from the BASA website, which is www.basa.org.au

Membership

Individuals can pay either \$75 for 12 months membership (2 seasons), or \$45 for one season's membership. This must be paid by midway through the season, or when the player qualifies to play in the finals (one third of the matches).

A "NO PAY NO PLAY" Policy applies for players who are behind in their payments, and who do not make suitable arrangements with the Treasurer.

The Game process.

Prior to the game:

- It is the Captains responsibility to go to the score-box, and mark on the scoresheet who from your team, is present and playing on the ice.
- Team Fees must be collected and paid to the Treasurer and if they are not available, any of the other Committee members.
- Note that rink rules prevent hitting practice drills with a ball on the small ice. Warm-ups e.g. running on the small ice is allowed.

During the game

- Captains are responsible for the behaviour of their team. A copy of the rules is available on the web-site, or from the Referee in Chief. You have a responsibility to know the rules, and guide your team members in abiding by the rules.
- Support the referees - they are volunteers, who give up their time to enable your game to happen. Referees may make mistakes, but remember that they also have an unbiased view of play - respect their decisions.

After the game

- Sign the scoresheet.
- Check whether your team has scoring duties. If teams continue to fail to turn up for scoring duties, then penalties will have to be devised and enforced.
- Ensure that your team does not leave rubbish lying around the change area.

Notes for Captains 22/7/08

1. Delegates meeting

There is a delegates meeting on the 29th July at 9:30pm at the Southwark Hotel. It is important that all teams are represented by their Captain, plus one Team member. The aim is a review of the season, and for the teams to have input into the future of BASA.

2. Reminder of the Female Player Rule

In the mixed competition, all teams must qualify a second female player by the end of the season. Failure to qualify a second female player will mean a one goal penalty in the final's games.

Next season all teams playing in the mixed competition will have to qualify 2 players, and field a female player on the ice at all times.

3. Qualifying Females for a Game

The IFBA rules state that a team must field the required number of players, dressed to play, on the bench at the start of the game.

Further to this,

1. BASA requires that the required number of players (including female players) be present on the bench for the duration of the game.
2. The penalty for not having the required number of players on the bench is as per IFBA rule 49 - forfeit of game.
3. If a player cannot continue to play, due to an injury or emergent event, and has to leave the bench, then this should be communicated to the referee at the next stoppage of play. The player may then leave the bench at the Referees discretion.
4. Next season, all players taking to the ice must fill out a registration form, even if they are only playing one game.
