WHAT IS THE ICE FACTOR?

The Ice Factor is a program to teach life skills to young people through membership in an ice hockey team.

The program involves the participation of 100 young people identified by High Schools.

The program teaches life skills to at risk and disadvantaged students who learn a sporting activity, a team identity and life skills. To remain eligible they must stay in the program and go to school, or change their behaviour at school so they are not excluded.

The Ice Factor is run by SAISF (a nonprofit voluntary group) and supported by the Government of South Australia, various schools, community sponsors, and volunteers.

Funds raised by the Ice Factor Spectacular will enable the program to continue and expand.
