We have been able to negotiate some very reasonable ice time for this years Nationals competition. The final session times will be determined by the final numbers of teams, however a draft schedule looks like this:

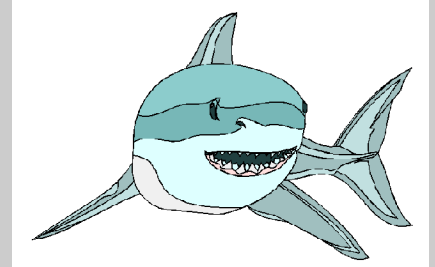
Thursday 4th June: Start 7am - Finish 11:00pm
